Directions to Seabeck Conference Center

13395 Lagoon Drive NW, Seabeck, WA 98380

Edmonds to Seabeck:

Go west on Kingston Edmonds ferry to WA SR 104 8.5 miles

Go northwest on WA SR 104 to WA SR 3 9.0 miles

Go south on WA SR 3 toward Bremerton 16.5 miles

Take the Newberry Hill exit and follow signs to Seabeck

Port Angeles to Seabeck:

Go Southeast on US 101 to WA SR 104 37 miles

Go Southeast on WA SR 104 (portions toll) to WA SR 3 15.5 miles

Go South on WA SR 3 toward Bremerton 16.5 miles

Take the Newberry Hill exit and follow signs to Seabeck

I-5 Corridor to Seabeck:

Go South or North on I-5 to WA SR 16 (Exit 132)

Go Northwest on WA SR 16 (pass Bremerton) to WA SR 3 27 mi.

Go North on WA SR 3 9.7 miles

Take the Newberry Hill exit and follow signs to Seabeck

Eastern WA to Seabeck

Depending on where you are located**

I-90 corridor over Snoqualmie Pass is usually the fastest;

Then use the I-5 Corridor instructions.
